



CBIC COVID-19 Return to In-Person Service Safety Protocol

Dear Central Members:

Greeting from Pastor K. Hodges, Sr. and Trustees Board Members.

We pray this correspondence finds you and your family well and safe. As you know we have decided to return to In-Person service in limited numbers beginning February 7, 2021. We are asking everyone attending in-person service to read, sign and return the attached COVID-19 waiver form to your deacon on your return to church.

In addition to the waiver form, listed below are steps we are taking to protect our church membership and keep our church operating safely.

- ➡ Performing temperature checks.
- ➡ Our Deacons will usher members to measured social distanced seating. Social distance seating will be further observed by only seating groups on every other pew.
- ➡ Installed electronic hand sanitizer machines and hand pump sanitizing stations will be clearly visible.
- ➡ Increased deep cleaning and sanitizing with the use of electrostatic spraying and aerosol disinfectant.
- ➡ Limiting the church attendance to a maximum of 35 members who have previously RSVP'd.
- ➡ Restricting entry into the Church facility to the West 3rd Street entrances (Front of Church).
- ➡ Restricting exiting the Church to the Jefferson Street side doors (Parking Lot).
- ➡ Reinforcing the importance of staying home if recently exposed to COVID-19, feeling sick, feverish or displaying other related symptoms.
